- Appellee has filed a Motion for In Camera Review of Disputed Public Record. Appellant has filed a Response to Appellee's Motion for In Camera Review of Disputed Public Record in which counsel for Appellant indicates Appellant does not object to Appellee's motion for in camera review of the confidential advisory opinion in this matter.
- [2] Having reviewed the matter, the Court finds and orders as follows:
 - 1. Appellee's Motion for In Camera Review of Disputed Public Record is granted.
 - 2. On or before July 19, 2023, Appellant is directed to file with the Clerk of this Court a physical confidential supplemental appendix volume containing a copy of the January 15, 2021 confidential advisory opinion of the Indiana Inspector General that the trial court reviewed *in camera*. The confidential supplemental appendix volume shall be conventionally filed in a sealed envelope and marked as "Confidential. Cannot be accessed by the public or Appellee-Plaintiff Barbara Tully."
 - 3. When the conventionally filed confidential supplemental appendix volume is received, the Clerk of this Court is specifically directed to: (1) accept the confidential document; (2) not scan the confidential document; (3) not make it accessible on the MyCase website; and (4) not otherwise make it accessible to the public or to Appellee.

- 4. Pursuant to the Court's May 26, 2023 order, Appellant's Brief remains due on July 19, 2023.
