APPELLEE'S MOTION FOR IN CAMERA REVIEW OF <u>DISPUTED PUBLIC RECORD</u>

Appellee Barbara Tully (Plaintiff below) hereby moves this Court to review *in camera* the January 15, 2021, opinion of the Indiana Inspector General that is the subject of her action under the Access to Public Records Act (APRA), and in support states:

- 1. Tully brought this action pursuant to APRA, Ind. Code section 5-14-3-1, *et seq.*, seeking to inspect and/or copy a January 15, 2021, opinion of the Indiana Inspector General dealing with the ethical issues arising out of Rokita's continuing to accept compensation from a private employer, Apex Benefits, after he was sworn in as Indiana Attorney General.
- 2. On May 20, 2022, the trial court granted Tully's motion to inspect that opinion *in camera* as permitted by I. C. 5-14-3-9(h). That report is part of the record on appeal but remains under seal.
- 3. This Court has held upon proper motion that public records reviewed *in camera* by the trial court must also be reviewed on appeal as a requirement of due process. *Groth v. Pence*, 67 N.E.3d 1104, 1113 (Ind. Ct. App. 2017).

4. In subsequent appeals involving APRA, this Court has granted motions to review

public records in camera that the trial court had previously reviewed but which remained under

seal on appeal. Sullivan v. National Elections Defense Coalition, 182 N.E.3d 859 (Ind. Ct. App.

2022); Tax Analysts, et al. v. Ind. Econ. Development Comm'n, 162 N.E.3d 1111, 1113 (Ind. Ct.

App. 2020).

WHEREFORE, Tully respectfully moves this Court to review in camera the unredacted

January 15, 2021, opinion of the Indiana Inspector General that is the public record in dispute in

this matter.
