## Order

On September 3, 2024, the Indiana Supreme Court Disciplinary Commission (“Commission”) filed its “First Petition for Extension of Time for Investigation” concerning its file numbers 24-0618 and 24-0608. The Commission alleges the two grievances were filed against the respondent on November 6, 2023, and November 8, 2023, respectively; the respondent requested and was granted multiple extensions of time to respond to the two grievances; some materials from four subpoenas duces tecum issued to the respondent in May 2024 remain outstanding; and a deposition of the respondent originally scheduled for August 2024 needed to be rescheduled due to outstanding discovery issues as well as proposed time constraints. The Commission seeks 90-day extensions in each of the two matters.

Being duly advised, the Court GRANTS the petition and extends the Commission’s deadline to complete its investigations of matters 24-0618 and 24-0608 **to and including February 4, 2025, for matter 24-0618, and to and including February 6, 2025, for matter 24-0608.**
