Dear Ms. Audrain:

You requested to file a quarterly campaign finance report on behalf of Greg Ballard. The Indiana Election Division is unable to complete your request because the co-directors of the Indiana Election Division are unable to agree to make changes in the campaign finance system to allow you to file a quarterly report.

The Indiana Election Division is a bi-partisan agency. The Indiana Supreme Court held in *Sammons v. Conrad*, 740 N.E.2d 114 (Ind. 2000), that the Indiana General Assembly intended the Election Division to be a bipartisan agency with equal staff that could act as an agency only when its co-directors agreed.

It is the opinion of the Republican Co-Director that the Election Division should accept your request to file additional campaign finance reports for public transparency.

The Democratic co-director believes the Division lacks the statutory authority to create a reporting period not explicitly provided for in law. In this case, the Greg for Indiana committee amended their statement of organization on April 2, 2026, to update the committee structure from an exploratory to principal committee. For this reason, the committee will have a Second Quarterly Report due in July with a filing period of Jan. 1, 2026, through June 30, 2026. This is due to the committee's decision to amend their CFA-1 after the first quarterly report filing period closed. However, this view does not prevent the committee from sharing publicly its campaign contributions and expenditures, just not through our antiquated campaign finance system.

Based on the *Sammons* ruling, the Indiana Election Division cannot agree to make changes to the campaign finance system to satisfy your request.
